


Jersey (the location of CIC's HQ) Hosts the "Island Games"

But my passion has always been athletics, and after giving up competitive athletics I coached the Jersey Junior Athletics team for many years; several of the athletes I trained have won medals in these Games, making me very proud. It is wonderful that sportsmen and sportswomen are able to compete at high level in friendly international competition, with opportunities for cultural exchange and social interaction amongst the visiting teams."
